

# A VISUAL GUIDE FOR

PARKING | SHUTTLE | WALK - TO LA JOLLA PLAYHOUSE

## PARKING AT THE SOUTH PARKING STRUCTURE (FORMERLY KNOWN AS OSLER PARKING STRUCTURE)



La Jolla Playhouse patrons park for free at the South Parking Structure (formerly known as Osler Parking Structure), located on Gilman Drive and Osler Lane. Enter the structure from Gilman Drive. Turn Right if headed north on Gilman drive, turn Left if headed south on Gilman Drive.



Once you enter the structure, look for the parking attendant who will give you a pass to put on your dashboard for your visit. No need to stop at the pay stations - **parking is free!**



## PARKING AT THE SOUTH PARKING STRUCTURE, CONTINUED

Go to Level 4,  
North Lobby exit to  
access the Playhouse  
shuttle or walking  
path to the theatre.  
Elevators and stairs  
are available.



## TO TAKE THE PLAYHOUSE SHUTTLE



Cross the pedestrian bridge and Osler Lane  
crosswalk to get to the Playhouse shuttle  
pick-up location.



TO TAKE THE PLAYHOUSE SHUTTLE, CONTINUED



Look for the **"Playhouse Shuttle"** and hop on board with your friendly shuttle driver! Shuttles are accessible.

TO WALK TO THE PLAYHOUSE



Exit via the pedestrian bridge at level 4 of the South Structure. Turn left after the bridge and look for the path and sign to La Jolla Playhouse. The walk is .30 miles, with a mild uphill ascent. The path is paved and lit at night.



*TO WALK TO THE PLAYHOUSE, CONTINUED*



Cross at the Gilman Osler Lane/Scholar's Drive intersection. Follow the Playhouse signs up the hill, past Ché Cafe.



At the top of the hill, turn right at Weiss Lane. At the end of Weiss Lane, you'll see the back of James' Place restaurant. You've arrived at the theatre district!



## VACCINATION / NEGATIVE COVID-19 CHECK



From both the shuttle drop off and the walking path, you will arrive at a vaccination / negative COVID-19 check in. A Playhouse audience concierge will check you in. Remember to bring a photo ID and proof of vaccination. [More details here.](#)
