JOB DESCRIPTION

Under the direction of the Stage Manager and Production Manager, the Sound/Video POP Tour technician serves as the onsite sound/video technician for the La Jolla Playhouse POP Tour.

This position will be responsible for the setup, strike, and maintenance of the sound and video equipment for all POP Tour performances and will be responsible for driving the POP Tour truck from La Jolla Playhouse to the venue each day.

About the POP Tour:

The La Jolla Playhouse Performance Outreach Program (POP) Tour, is an annual touring production for young people that tours San Diego County elementary schools during February, March and April each year.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work closely with the Production Assistant and Actors to load in, trouble shoot, run, and strike the sound and video the technical rehearsals and tour of the show
- Responsible for the maintenance of sound/video equipment including wireless mics and video system in a new venue each day
- Work under the direction of the Stage Manager to load and unload all physical elements of the production to and from the truck while on tour
- Reports to the Sound and Video Supervisor
- Responsible for driving a 15' box truck to local San Diego Schools
- Fill out time sheet each week
- Abide by all safety requirements
- Regularly lift and maneuver heavy (50 lbs.) scenic, video, and sound elements

QUALIFICATIONS

- The ideal candidate will have a strong background in and understanding of theatre practices; will be a self-starter and able to work in a fast-paced environment
- Technical/Production skills a must, including thorough understanding of sound and video equipment
- Be responsive to artistic needs in a fast-paced and detail-critical environment
- Knowledge of and dedication to safe working practices, OSHA 10 a plus
- Able to work under the stress of deadlines and adapt to changing priorities while maintaining a positive and productive attitude
- Ability to climb and work on ladders
- Ability to regularly lift 50lbs
- Valid Driver's License, clean driving record, and access to reliable transportation
